Be sure to make this trip - the scenery is breathtaking!








Lake Louise/Banff Trip -- Feb. 20 - 27, 1999

Plans are under way for a great trip to the Canadian Rockies for February of 1999. Alison was able to go on a Lake Louise FAM trip early in April. She brought back some great ideas for our group functions. One must do item is their Torch Light dinner. Lake Louise is rated as having the most spectacular scenery of any ski resort in North America. The main two ski areas are Lake Louise the largest and Sunshine which offers above the tree line skiing. Mt. Norquay is a smaller area outside the town of Banff which is included in your ski pass. Two independent areas available are Panarma and Nakiska.

There will be two lodging options one around \$850 staying Banff and the other at \$1186 staying in the two world class Canadian Pacific "castle" hotels, half the week at the Chateau Lake Louise and half the week in the Banff Springs Hotel.






Multipurpose Canopy
