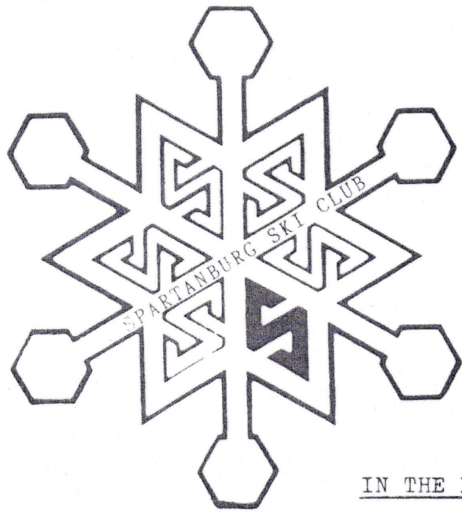

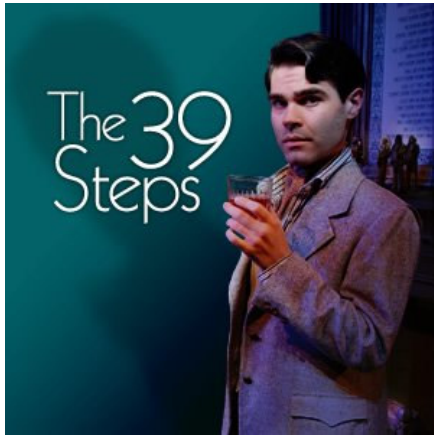

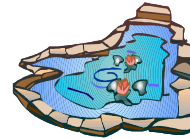
JULY POOL PARTY
