




### **Crescent Racing**

Now that fall is here it is time to prepare for the upcoming Crescent race season. Step up your exercise program and check your ski equipment to see if it needs upgrading. Early season race clinics at Steamboat, Sugar Mountain and Appalchain Ski Mountain are all great ways to improve your skiing.

Crescent racer fees are \$35 for adults and \$20 for students. The fees must be received by Crescent by the end of November so I will be taking payments at our October and November meetings and by mail. Cash or check made out to the Spartanburg Ski Club. Our club wants members to represent us in Crescent racing so it will reimburse skiers that race at least two days \$20 at the end of the season.

The first race is scheduled for Appalachain Ski Mountain on December 20th. See full race schedule in this issue.

Join your fellow SSOC members for a day in beautiful Tryon. We will start with an easy hike on the Blue Wall section of the Palmetto Trail. We will explore two small lakes and a waterfall that lie between Lake Lanier and Hogback Mountain. Wear walking shoes, bring something to drink and a snack. Meet at 9:30 in the strip mall parking lot across from the Lake Lanier entrance. This is on Highway 176 aproximately 100 yards beyond the SC/NC line.

Following our hike we will go into Tryon for the optional Tryon Beer Fest. Admission is by ticket only. The \$30 ticket gets you unlimited craft beer or wine. You must be 18 to attend. A German Octoberfest band, Mountain Top Polka, plays till 4:00 and an Americona/folk rock band, Trophy Husbands, plays till 8:00. German food and pizza will be available for purchase. There is an Oyster roast ticket for an additional \$20. This ticket must be pre purchased.

For those not wanting to enjoy the beer fest you can view art galleries, eat at Sidestreet Pizza, drive out to Tryon Equestrain Center or shop. Sign up at our club meeting or mail check to me made out to Mark McCall, 185 Thoroughbred Ln, Tryon, NC.





### **SSOC Trip and Event Policies**

- 1. All SSOC trip participants must be a member in good standing with the SSOC and/or Crescent Ski Council, OR a guest of a member in good standing.
- 2. When required from Crescent, each applicant must submit a signed registration form, along with a deposit to the Trip Director or Tour Operator, before the trip.
- 3. Checks returned to SSOC for non-sufficient funds will incur a \$10.00 club fee, plus any bank charges incurred for each check. These fees will be paid immediately to the club treasurer upon notification, or member forfeits participation in any CLUB activity until fees and check amount are repaid.
- 4. No one is signed up with an SSOC trip/event until deposit (if required) is made. With trips/events where no deposit is required no one is confirmed as signed up until payment is made in full.
- 5. Once a trip or event is filled, a wait list will be established giving priority to registered applicants in the order deposit was received, (if necessary for the trip/event), or if no deposit is necessary, then priority will be given to those on the wait list in the order of sign up.
- 6. When lodging is involved, and room/condo or cabin mates are needed, a wait list will be started. If a deadline approaches and the room is not filled and must be dropped, "full occupancy" price of lodging would need to be paid by the individual at an extra cost to that person. If deposit has been made and the person on the wait list decides not to attend, a refund for any deposit will be given as long as it is NOT past the deadline.
- 7. If a member decides to drop out of the trip/event after payment is made in full, it is the member's responsibility to try and find someone to replace them, the club will not subsidize an empty space. That member can resell that space or ticket however they want to, to another member. If no substitute can be found, a refund will be made IF there is no penalty to the club. If a penalty occurs it will be at the canceling member's expense. Late fees will only be paid by SSOC if the fee is incurred due to the club's error.
- 8. When a trip application is submitted to Crescent, applicant must comply with Crescent's own guidelines. This includes airfare arranged by Crescent, Land Packages, Lodging, prepaid activities, ground transportation, and anything not considered "optional". Crescent does allow for members to book their own airfare, but you will need to verify this with them at that time.
- 9. The club is not responsible for any financial losses, property damage, personal injury due to weather conditions or other events. Club is NOT responsible for lost tickets. Members who lose a ticket or voucher must replace it by buying a new

one. Club does not issue refunds, once a ticket is bought, if the member cannot use it, it is up to them to try and find another member who is willing to buy it, or they will be responsible for the loss. Refund policies established by any Provider or Facility (example: Flatrock Playhouse) will be upheld by SSOC.

- 10. On overnight trips, children, under 18 years of age, must be accompanied by an adult. If the adult is not the parent or guardian, a written agreement by the parent or guardian must give responsibility to the adult accompanying the child.
- 11. Crescent deadlines are NOT necessarily the deadline for SSOC members. Deposit dates, final dates and cancellation dates WILL be enforced.
- 12. No refunds are guaranteed unless specified, and refunds are given at the discretion of the board.
- 13. All checks for SSOC functions will be made out to SSOC and given to member in charge of the event unless otherwise specified, and member in charge will turn funds into the treasurer with proper finance forms.

The Board (at any regular or special meeting) reserves the right to revise or clarify the Club Trip and Events Policies.
