

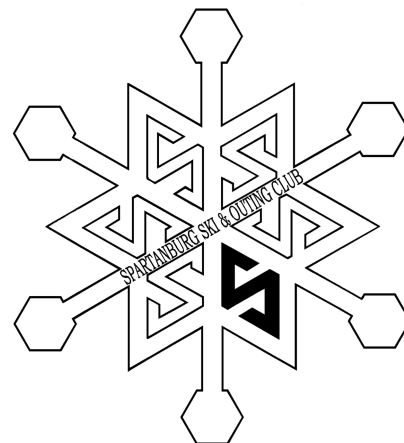

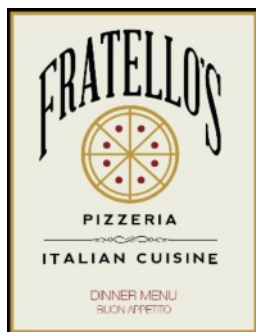
# Brevard Music Center

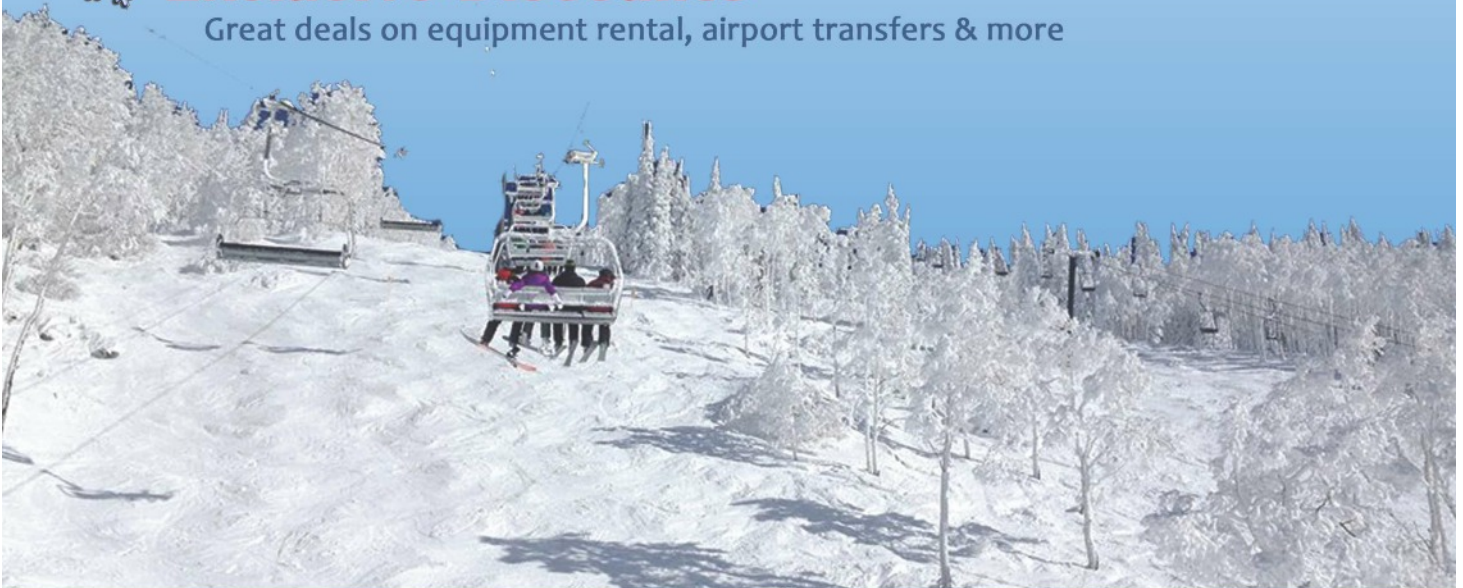

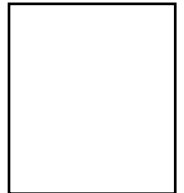


