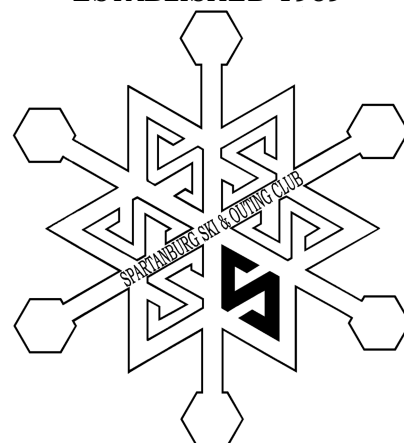

Included in the package: Lodging for two or three nights, three or four day lift tickets, (Thursday thru Sunday, or Friday thru Sunday), races, and Saturday night awards.

Lodging: Condos at Silvercreek Resort, on the slopes at Silvercreek, at Snowshoe Mountain.

Accommodation options include Studio, 1 Bedroom, 1 Bedroom plus loft, and 2 Bedroom units.
(All units include sleeper sofas). Rates **per person** for each type of lodging are shown on page 2.

Juniors, under 12, not using a pillow are not charged for lodging. They must pay for lift tickets, if they are skiing. There are no discounts for juniors for either the 4 day ticket, or the 3 day special ticket. Because of this, **juniors who race will be charged \$20 each.**

4 day, (Thurs – Sunday) - \$227
3 day (Friday – Sunday) - \$172
1 day (Saturday) - \$87

Teens pay adult rates for 3 or 4 day lift tickets and beds. One day lift ticket = \$92.

Adult Lift tickets: 4 day (Thursday – Sunday) - \$227
3 day (Friday – Sunday) - \$172

The tickets are 4 days, and 3 day special tickets. 1 day tickets are \$103 making a 2 day ticket more expensive than the 3 day ticket. **All packages are based on the 3 day special ticket.** If you want the 4 day ticket, add \$55 per ticket. **The special 3 day tickets are non refundable**

Off site skiers can purchase lift tickets at the above rate.

Participants who do not need lift tickets, may subtract the cost of tickets from their trip costs. **You need to let the trip leader know if you don't need lift tickets before the trip, otherwise you pay for them anyway.**

Off site racers must pay an additional off site racing fee of \$65 to cover Race expenses.

On Friday, gates will be set up, at Silvercreek, for racer training. The cost is to be determined. Participants can pay and sign waivers at top of course.

Cancellation Policy:

1. Rooms must be dropped 45 days before arrival, or a \$25 fee will be incurred for each room dropped. That fee will be charged to any group that causes Crescent to incur it.
2. Rooming lists must be provided at least 14 days before arrival, or a \$50 fee will be charged. That fee will be charged to any group that causes Crescent to incur it.
3. Here is what will happen. At 45 days before arrival, all rooms that are not reserved, WILL BE DROPPED. 45 days from arrival is 1/20/20 After that, any group needing more room can contact the trip leader to add a room or rooms. There is no guarantee that rooms will be available. Snowshoe is tightening up its reservation requirements and we must do the same.
4. As stated earlier, lift tickets are not refundable. You must let the trip leader know who does or doesn't need lift tickets on the Monday before the trip. Your club will pay for any unclaimed tickets that Crescent has to pay for.

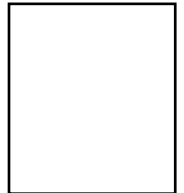
